The National Commission on Human Rights and Freedoms (NCHRF) will on the 7th of December 2017 from 8:00am at the esplanade of the National Museum in Yaounde, launch activities to commemorate the 69th edition of the International Human Rights Day under the theme «*Human Rights Education as medium for Peace, Security and Sustainable Development*».

This opening ceremony will also have the launching of the first ever edition of the trade fare of the employment of persons living with disabilities that will be followed by a panel discussion on the theme «*Fundamental freedoms and impending dangers of social networks*».
